### ◆MAX. WEIGHT:

All special orders are subject to freight charges. Total freight charges depend on boat size, packaging requirements, where the boat is being shipped from, and the number of other boats we are able to combine in one shipment. ## GLOSSARY

**Recreation/Sporting Kayaks** - Recreation/Sporting kayaks are designed with an emphasis on initial stability. These kayaks typically have more width and larger cockpits for maximum comfort and safety. These "hop-in-and-go" designs are easy to paddle and user-friendly. These are the perfect kayaks for local ponds and other protected waterways. Certain models also make good choices for fishing or wildlife photography; such boats are referred to as Sporting Boats.

**Sit-on Top (SOT) Kayaks** – SOT kayaks are open cockpit designs that emphasize stability, safety and ease of entry/exit. These self-bailing designs can be specific for ocean surf, whitewater rivers, and touring.

**Whitewater Kayaks** – Whitewater kayaks are cutting edge hull designs created specifically for executing moves on a whitewater river. These kayaks are typically short in length, heavily rockered (sort of banana shaped), don't track well but are highly maneuverable.

**Hybrid Kayaks** - Hybrid kayaks are designed to bridge the gap between recreation, whitewater and touring kayaks. They are suitable for both flat water and moderately fast moving rivers. These boats are a compromise between high performance touring kayaks, whitewater kayaks and user-friendly recreation kayaks. Imagine a mountain bike with road bike tires... you get the idea. These are great introductory boats for getting started in paddle sports.

**Touring Kayaks** – Touring kayaks are designed with an emphasis on efficiency, sea worthiness, tracking and load capacity. If your paddling interests are local lakes, estuaries or open oceans, a touring kayak is the boat of choice. Touring kayaks are manufactured for a wide variety of paddler sizes. Keep in mind that body shapes vary widely from person to person; there is no substitute for sitting in a kayak to evaluate the "comfort factor".

**Notes on Polymer Hull Materials:** There are a wide variety of plastic substances used in the manufacture of kayaks. Some of the more popular ones are described below:

**LPE:** Linear Polyethylene. This is the most widely used polymer. It is fairly stiff, durable and relatively inexpensive.

**SLPE:** Super Linear Polyethylene. This polymer has excellent shape retention (memory). Stiffer and more durable than LPE, this material is also more expensive.

**FCP:** Foam Core Polyethylene. Extremely stiff and durable, this material is stiffer than SLPE and as durable a LPE.

**TFP:** Thermoformed Polymer. A relatively new material for canoe and kayak manufacture, TFP offers stiffness approaching Fiberglass with weights substantially lower than any other plastic. TFP boats are also the most expensive of the polymer materials. TFP boats have the appearance of gel coated Composite boats at a lower cost.
