GLOSSARY

Whitewater Kayaks – Whitewater kayaks are cutting edge hull designs created specifically for executing moves on a whitewater river. These kayaks are typically short in length, heavily rockered (sort of banana shaped), don't track well but highly maneuverable. Some popular types of whitewater kayaks are described below:

Creek Kayaks (Crk) are specialized kayaks designed with an emphasis on maneuverability and buoyancy. These kayaks are generally short, high volume and highly rockered. They are suitable for paddling steep creeks and rivers that drop a significant vertical feet per mile.

Park and Play Kayaks (P&P) are highly specialized kayaks designed to perform more difficult retentive moves and other fancy tricks. Although these kayaks are best suited for advanced paddlers, they are also enjoyable for intermediate boaters looking to play on smaller river features.

River Play Kayaks (RP) fall somewhere between River Runner Kayaks and Park and Play Kayaks in their usage. These versatile, fun boats are great for surfing waves and holes, performing a variety of vertical tricks, while retaining predictable river running characteristics. They are best suited for aggressive novices to more experienced boaters.

River Runner Kayaks (RR) are the most generalized of the whitewater kayaks. They are stable, comfortable and generally more predictable on difficult whitewater. For these reasons, River Runner kayaks are best suited for novices and those venturing on more challenging rivers.

Notes on Polymer Hull Materials: There are a wide variety of plastic substances used in the manufacture of kayaks. Some of the more popular ones are described below:

LPE: Linear Polyethylene. This is the most widely used polymer. It is fairly stiff, durable and relatively inexpensive.

SLPE: Super Linear Polyethylene. This polymer has excellent shape retention (memory). Stiffer and more durable than LPE, this material is also more expensive.

FCP: Foam Core Polyethylene. Extremely stiff and durable, this material is stiffer than SLPE and as durable a LPE.

TFP: Thermoformed Polymer. A relatively new material for canoe and kayak manufacture, TFP offers stiffness approaching Fiberglass with weights substantially lower than any other plastic. TFP boats are also the most expensive of the polymer materials. TP boats have the appearance of gel coated Composite boats at a lower cost.

Accessory Ideas

Quality paddle, comfortable PFD, flotation, throw rope or rescue system, nose plugs, sprayskirt, seat padding, hip pads, thigh pads, dry bags (various sizes), helmet, elbow pads, paddling socks or shoes, gloves or pogies, dry top, paddling jacket, next to skin layer, wet suit, cockpit cover, cartop system, tie-down straps, UV spray protectant, guide book, instructional DVD/book, join a paddling club.
